Interested in becoming a mentor? Follow these 2 steps!

- 1. Make sure your experience fulfills the following criteria:
 - 2 years with MSF, including 1 year with OCP and 2 assignments each at least 6 consecutive months long
 - Less than 5 years since your last assignment
 - Ideally, all mentors should have completed a full year's cycle in their profile
 - <u>Mentors for coordination positions:</u> experience in 2 different contexts in the mentee's position (or different detachments, missions, or projects in one country), with at least 6 consecutive months in 1 context
 - <u>Mentors for project positions:</u> experience in 3 different contexts in the mentee's position, with at least 6 consecutive months in 2 contexts
