

## Mentoring Group Supervision 2024

### Continuous professional Development for MSF Mentors

The Mentoring Group Supervision is part of the Continuous Professional Development (CPD) offer for MSF mentors, which aims to meet needs identified by you, the MSF mentors, to keep developing relevant skills and knowledge, and to have a mentoring community to do so and stay connected.

#### What:

- Static Group: 4 sessions of 90 min, once a month.
- One-Time group session, 90 min.

#### Why:

- To share experiences, dilemmas, and challenges, reflect on your mentoring practice, learn from one another, and establish a support network - and by doing so, provide better support to your mentees.
- The supervision offered qualifies for the supervision hours required for renewal of the EMCC Global Individual Accreditation (EIA).

#### Who:

For mentors who seek a community and want to take their mentoring career and commitment to the next level, and who have completed one or more mentoring relationships. The group will consist of 4-6 mentors and a group facilitator.

#### How:

Facilitated sessions where mentors take turns in talking and designing the type of support they wish to receive from the group. The group facilitators are experienced mentors.
